## **Continuing Education**

The NAHMT or NAHMS credential holder will need to maintain their active status by completing 4 continuing education units per year.

- You will also need eight (8) hours of training in at least four different maintenance-specific topics. Topics can include but are not limited to Electrical, Plumbing, HVAC, Appliances, Construction, etc.
- You will also need to complete four (4) hours of fair housing training
