In 2015, 85 worthy student residents received \$2,500 each. This is the largest number of scholarship recipients ever selected in a single year.

The courses of study for scholarship applicants include education, business, engineering, history, pre-medicine, finance, marine biology, nursing, fine arts, music and liberal arts to name a few. Applicants have ranged in age from 17 to 58 and have come from a wide variety of ethnic and religious backgrounds.

To date, funds for the scholarships have been raised primarily through fundraising efforts such as our Annual June fundraiser event, Ask Campaign or Poster Auction.
