THE PROBLEM

We all need a decent, affordable home. Yet today, in communities across America, millions are without this basic necessity. For every 100 extremely low income renter households in the United States, there are only 31 affordable and available units. The shortage gets worse every year; it is why people are homeless in our country.

THE SOLUTION

Once funded, the National Housing Trust Fund will expand, preserve, rehabilitate, and maintain the supply of rental housing affordable to America's poorest families. The National Housing Trust Fund was authorized by Congress in 2008 but remains unfunded while the need for affordable housing for the lowest income households is at an all-time high.

HOW WE CAN ACHIEVE THIS

The United for Homes campaign proposes to fund the National Housing Trust Fund through modifications to the mortgage interest deduction. The changes are simple: Reduce the size of a mortgage eligible for a tax break to \$500,000, and convert the deduction to a 15% non-refundable tax credit. Our campaign proposal would create more than \$200 billion in revenue over ten years that could be used to fund the National Housing Trust Fund.
