NAHMA's Winter Meeting Starts Sunday

Alexandria, Va., March 2, 2016 — The National Affordable Housing Management Association (NAHMA)'s Federal Affairs Issues [winter meeting](#), gets underway in a matter of days. While the online registration is closed, on-site registrations will be welcomed.

The three-day NAHMA winter meeting, March 6-8, is focused on federal policy issues and features a number of educational panels specifically geared toward the affordable housing industry that are led by the people who are experts in their fields.

This year's meeting will feature an expanded Department of Housing and Urban Development component. The HUD Leadership Forum takes place Monday morning followed later that day by the HUD Management Issues Forum. Also different from years past, the Certification Review Board and Education & Training committees will be holding a joint session Sunday. New this year, a microphone Catchbox, sponsored by Dauby O'Connor & Zaleski, will be used for the Sunday meetings in the Roosevelt room.

The meeting also includes networking opportunities, industry awards, Communities of Quality (COQ) awards luncheon and keynote speaker Danny Vargas, corporate chief executive officer and political activist. The event concludes with prearranged Capitol Hill meetings with congressional representatives and their staff. The winter meeting takes place at the Fairmont Washington, 2401 M St. NW, Washington, DC.
