The primary purpose of the redesigned NAHMA website is to provide information to its members. That information includes Membership, portal entrance for Trends online community forum, Affordable 100 list, Advocacy, Government Updates, Meetings, Educational opportunities, Awards and Contests, and a Members-Only section. The information needs to be able to be provided through different mediums (i.e., webpages, press releases, PDF links, video, etc.). The site must also allow members to complete financial transactions. Additionally, the redesign should enable future integration with the association's database.
